OPD treatment in private recognized hospitals is not permitt viz., Noida, Gurgaon, Faridabad and Ghaziabad , wherein the CMO i/c can directly refer the beneficiaries to recognized hosp Cardiac surgery, Cancer treatment, Kidney transplantation, Hi Accident cases.

OPD medicines are to be collected through concerned dispen case reimbursement shall be considered by HOD of departme case of pensioners , etc.,

In permitted post operative cases , for conditions as stated chemist and claim reimbursement. However, an utilization cer be submitted.
